## LEADERTIP

### TRUSTWORTHY LEADERS ARE CREDIBLE

*(sixth in a series of nine)*

The word “credible” means the quality of being believable or worthy of trust. For those of us in ministry credibility is critical to our success and effectiveness in relationships and ministry. To be credible involves two foundational beliefs:

**The First Foundation of a credible life is how/what we think about ourselves.** Do we trust ourselves? Psychologists have reminded us that how we feel about ourselves is largely developed within the first three years of life. How our parents respond to our needs, the tones of voice spoken to us, how people respond to us and the climate established in our home, largely determines our self-image. A positive self-image strongly influences our self-confidence. Self-confidence has a direct influence on our performance in life.

My first ministry leadership position came during the summer of my sixteenth year. The Music Director of our church moved to another city and our Pastor asked me to become the Music Director. My first response, “No way, I’m only sixteen!” Then he asked, “Now, Harrell, are you not in the band and know how to read music?” Yes, I replied. “Don’t you know how to wave your hands and keep a beat?” Again, yes. “I know you know how to sing for I have heard you sing before. It seems to me you have all the skills necessary to lead worship and lead choir practice. I will work with you and show you how to lead worship effectively. You can begin this Sunday!!!!”

I may have had all the necessary skills to lead worship at age sixteen, but one critical aspect I did not possess was self-confidence. My parents and grandmother gave me an incredible positive self-image, but self-confidence to lead worship before 150 people. . . I don’t know! Well, I did lead worship that Sunday and every other Sunday for the next two years. Each week my self-confidence grew. I began to believe in myself and gained self-credibility through leading worship. This music ministry position laid the foundation for future ministry, both during my college years as well as adulthood.

**The Second Foundation of a credible life is how others trust you. Credibility is based on our being believable and being worthy of trust.** For those of us in ministry that involves a much higher calling. Henri J.M. Nouwen reminds Christian leaders, “It is not enough for the priests and ministers of the future to be moral people, well trained, eager to help their fellow humans, and able to respond creatively to the burning issues of their time. All of that is very valuable and important, but it is not the heart of Christian leadership. The central question is, are the leaders of the future truly men and women of God, people with an ardent desire to dwell in God’s presence, to listen to God’s voice, to look at God’s beauty, to touch God’s incarnate Word and to taste fully God’s infinite goodness? (*In the Name of Jesus*, pgs. 28-32.)

Trustworthy leaders must first have the self-confidence necessary to build the personal trust they need to lead effectively. Additionally, we must be people of God, who know how to dwell in His presence, listen to his voice, follow his leadership and impart his infinite goodness to our very contemporary society.
